- Responded to over 65 emails that needed attention

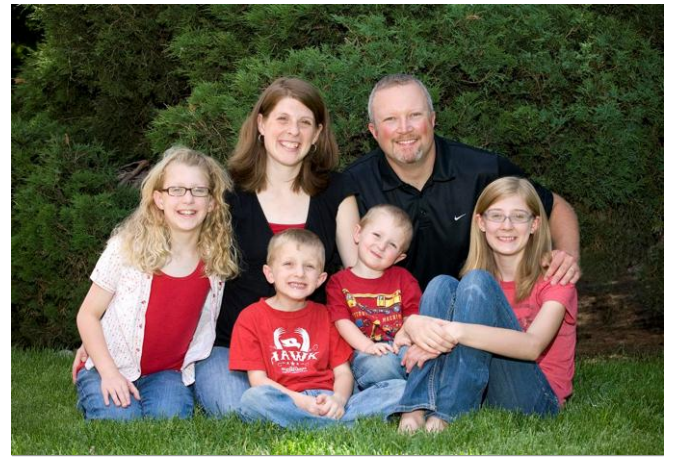
